To enroll in the Alaska Safety Alliance NSTC Unescorted Training:

- Visit this link: NSTC Unescorted Training
- Select Enroll
- Select **Buy Now \$205** (the discounted rate for "Local 302 AOEETT" is \$143.50)
- Select Create Account
- Fill out the account profile screen; List your Company as "Local 302 AOEETT"; DO NOT fill out employee ID & NSTC Card Number
- Confirm you have read, understand, and agree by checking the associated boxes and selecting Accept
- Your NSTC card and books will be mailed to the address you provide in the account created
- If you wish to pick up your NSTC card from Alaska Safety Alliance (ASA) rather than have it mailed to you, you must inform ASA upon completion of your training

How to take the training:

- Use a Chrome browser if possible and make sure you have a strong internet connection
- Once you have paid, you may immediately proceed to your training by going to your **Home Tab** (top left)
- Take your training on anything with audio and a large screen (no cell phones)
- There are no time limits on this course, so you may start and stop whenever you like, as many times as you like, but there are limits on how many times you attempt and fail the test
- This course takes approximately 4.5 hours total to complete.

Please note: to receive reimbursement the AWIB Grant Application Form must also be completed and turned in with proof that you successfully completed the NSTC class (copy of your certificate) and paid the \$143.50 fee (receipt).
